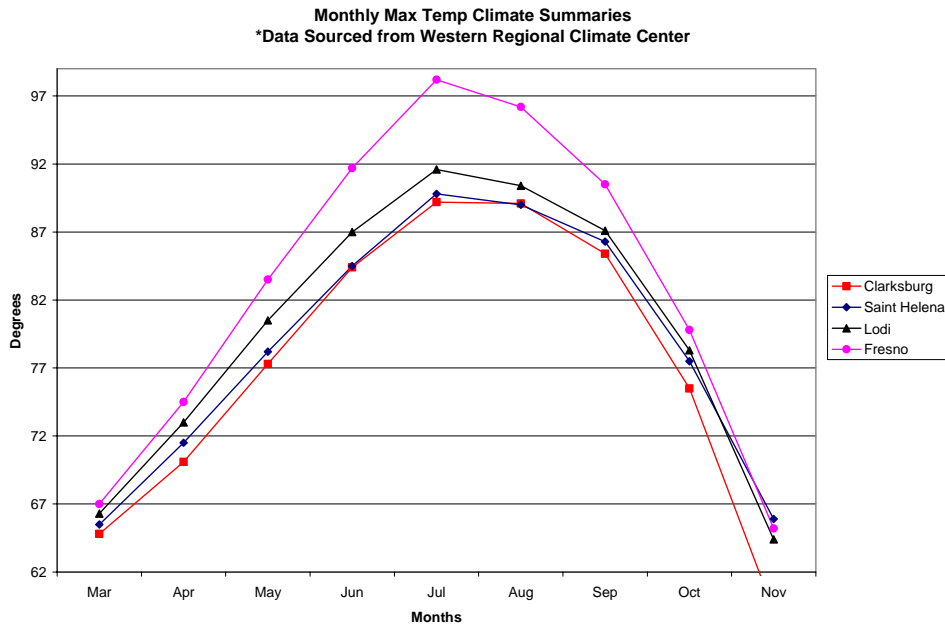


Climate & Soils

The climate of the Clarksburg AVA can be characterized as marine. The warm days and cool nights along with the “Delta Breeze” creates a moderately long growing season with ample airflow and light to create award winning wines. Comparisons to other wine growing regions can be seen in the table below.



The soils of the Clarksburg AVA vary greatly. Even on the same farm you could have four different types of soils. The soils in the area match the varieties grown. With mineralized, sandy, or peat soils there is a match to grow great grapes. With ample water following through the Sacramento River, the main artery of the Clarksburg AVA, there is no risk of fields drying up even in the driest of years.
